Clarification questions for the New Fire Agency Feasibility Study RFP

1. Can you provide an indication of what has been budgeted for this project, or other cost sharing agreements between the participating agencies?

Phase one of this project is hiring a consultant for the feasibility study. Currently the five agencies have funded this effort for approximately \$57,000. That amount could change based on what we think is best upon receiving proposals for the work.

2. Can you provide an indication of the timeframe of completion or a target election date that the participating agencies are shooting for?

We are targeting the general election in November 2022.

3. What role will the consultant play in helping facilitate any tax exchange agreement(s) between the city and/or county? What negotiations or discussions have already taken place?

The five agencies have been working on the project for roughly two years now, and during that time we have meet with County officials and discussed tax sharing options. Based on that interaction I would say there would be a very minimal role for the consultant other than advising us on other options.
